Net Zero

- Deliver a climate strategy for achieving net zero 2040, supported by science-based greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reduction targets validated by the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) using a FY17 baseline:

Net-zero GHG emissions across the value chain by FY40

Short-term science-based target FY25:

- o Reduce Scopes 1, 2 & 3 GHG emissions by 34%
- o 100% Renewable Electricity

Near-term science-based target FY30:

- o Reduce Scopes 1 & 2 GHG emissions by 55%
- o Reduce Scope 3 (FLAG) GHG emissions by 40%
- o Reduce Scope 3 (Non-FLAG) GHG emissions by 55%
- o No deforestation across primary deforestation-linked commodities

Long-term science-based target FY40:

- o Reduce Scope 1 & 2 GHG emissions by 90%
- o Reduce Scope 3 (FLAG) GHG emissions by 72%
- o Reduce Scope 3 (Non-FLAG) GHG emissions by 90%

- Act sustainably and reduce food waste to create a hunger-free world
